To ensure smooth and safe arrival and dismissal for our students, please be reminded of the following information:

SCHOOL HOURS: 9:25 a.m. – 3:55 p.m.

ARRIVAL TIMES: 9:15 a.m. First bell rings/students may enter the building.

9:25 a.m. Second/late bell rings/students should be in the classroom.

Students should not be dropped off or let out of your vehicle until 9:15 a.m. Supervision is not guaranteed for all students before this time. Before and after care is available through Columbia Association as well as other before and after school providers in the community.

All children who are late must be accompanied by a parent and be signed into school in the front office.

#### DISMISSAL TIMES: Dismissal begins at 3:45 p.m.

If you need to change your student's dismissal, please send a note to their teacher. If you need to make a change during the day, after your student has arrived at school, please email your child's teacher **AND** call the front office. No students will be released from the front office for early dismissal after 3:30pm. This will help to ensure the safety of our students and cut down on confusion at the end of the day as afternoon dismissal begins.
