Arriving to School by Bus

For families that receive bus transportation, bus stop information for the 2023-2024 school year is available now and can be accessed online via the Bus Stop Locator or HCPSS Connect Synergy under More Options and then Homeroom / Transportation / POS.

Both of these sites are updated regularly so check back often for more information.

Walkers and Car Riders

For families that do not receive bus transportation, if your child will be walking or riding their bike to school, We encourage you to take time now to familiarize your child with their route to and from school. Map out and walk the route between your home and school to ensure all roads, sidewalks and pathways are familiar for your child. In addition, review crosswalks and intersections that are safe for crossing the road if required and review <u>safe pedestrian tips</u> with your student. If you encounter any issues regarding safety as you walk these routes with your student, please contact the <u>HCPSS Office of Student Transportation</u> to make HCPSS staff aware.

Adults are not permitted to escort their child to their classroom. We have staff assigned to help direct students to their classroom each morning

Car Rider Dismissal

For students who will be car riders at dismissal, students will receive a hanging tag for the rearview mirror. Please write the student's last name on the tag with a permanent marker. This process will assist with dismissal procedures.

Dismissal for Walkers and Bike Riders

Students who are walkers can walk alone, with a friend(s), or have someone waiting for them at the designated areas at 3:40. We do not have staff available to watch children after dismissal who are waiting for someone that is scheduled to meet the child(ren). Please make sure that you practice your child(ren) route so they are prepared to walk home each day.

Health Room Medication

Medication Drop Off will be available on Thursday August 24rd and August 25th between 9:00 am and 3:00 pm. If your child requires medication (prescription or over the counter) during the school day, your child's health care provider must complete a <u>medication form</u> and/or an <u>Epi-Pen Care form</u> dated after July 1st, 2021. All prescribed medications must be in properly labeled containers that include the following information:

- Student name
- Medication name
- Dose to be given
- Time & Frequency of medication
- Prescriber's name & signature
- Date of medication order

Pharmacy labels will usually contain this information. Over-the-counter medications should be new, unopened containers labeled with the student's name. A parent or guardian must deliver the medication to the health room.

School Lunch/Free and Reduced Meals (FARMS)

Breakfast and lunch are served daily for all students at EES. Daily meal prices apply to students who do not qualify for free and reduced meals. The cost of breakfast is \$2.00 and the cost of lunch is \$2.80. Students from households that meet federal income guidelines are eligible to receive free or reduced-price meals. Parents/guardians must submit an application every year to maintain their student's eligibility. All families are asked to use this link to apply. **This application must be completed each year. ** Any family who has not filled out an application up to the 30th school day will have their prior status changed to full pay status until a new application is received.
