#### **MAP TESTING**

Thunder Hill will administer the Measured Academic Progress (MAP) assessment to all students in 1st through 5th grades in Reading and Math between September 19 - October 14. The data from the MAP assessment will help schools and teachers measure your student's academic progress. The MAP test does not affect grades and the difficulty adjusts depending on how your child responds. It is normal for students to only answer about half the questions correctly. 
