This has been a collaborative effort with the Restorative Justice Partnership, <u>Howard County</u> <u>Education Association (HCEA)</u>, and the <u>HCPSS Office of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion</u>. Students in grades 3-5 and all staff will be completing a survey to provide feedback on this effort and our progress as a school.

MAP TESTING

Thunder Hill will administer the Measured Academic Progress (MAP) assessment to all students in 1st through 5th grades in Reading and Math between September 19 - October 14. The data from the MAP assessment will help schools and teachers measure your student's academic progress. The MAP test does not affect grades and the difficulty adjusts depending on how your child responds. It is normal for students to only answer about half the questions correctly. Please check with students to see if they need headphones to use at school. The HCPSS website contains detailed information about MAP testing <u>here</u>.
