## **New Information**

#### **Family File Information:**

Every year HCPSS parents must complete a Family File (electronic emergency card) for each child. HCPSS utilizes Family File for parents/guardians to complete emergency information. The Family File for this year is now available. Parents/guardians must verify and/or update information for each child, and can do so by logging in to <a href="HCPSS Connect">HCPSS Connect</a> and selecting the "More Options" tab on the left and then clicking on "Family File" from the list. If your child was in an HCPSS school in previous years, you only need to update any changes. *Please update/provide the info ASAP. Thank you!!!* 

Once logged in, you will be asked to update or provide the following information:

- Student Information
- Parent/Guardian Contact
- Emergency Contacts
- Medical Information
- Arrival/Dismissal Procedures
- Photo Approval
- Data Confidentiality
- PTA/PTSA Directory

#### **Chromebooks**

If you have a child in kindergarten through 5th grade who still has a Chromebook laptop at home, please return the Chromebook to school with the charging cord. We will unassign your child from the Chromebook.

This year, students in elementary school will not have their own assigned Chromebook, they will use computers that are available to each grade. Thank you.

#### Student Clothing, Lunchboxes, and Water Bottles

Each year, we have many items in our Lost and Found. At times, the pile is HUGE! As you help your child get ready for the school year, please consider labeling all of their clothing, lunchbox and water bottle. This helps us to return items to the children. Thank you for your assistance.

#### **Student Absences**

Just a reminder that parents/guardians must turn in a note if the child is absent. The note should include the student's name, date absent, reason for absence, and parent/guardian signature. We also accept these notes through an email address. Please email <a href="mailto:THESabsence@hcpss.org">THESabsence@hcpss.org</a> with the same information if you prefer this format. Please submit notes within two days of your child returning to school.

#### **Release of Students During School Hours**

Parents must report to the front office when picking up their child for an early dismissal. Students will be called to the school office for dismissal upon the parent's arrival. If someone other than the parent/guardian is picking up a child for an early dismissal, the person must be granted permission as indicated on the emergency card or by providing a note from the parent/guardian. Early release of students close to the regular dismissal time is discouraged. Please note: In order to not disrupt dismissal procedures, the office staff will not be able to call individual students down for parent pick up after 3:30 p.m. Please bring a drivers license or ID when picking up a student for early dismissal.

### **Related Arts**

Related Arts and the Color Calendar Schedule

Students participate in Related Arts daily for one hour. There are five related arts classes: Art, Media, Music, Physical Education, and Technology. During the pandemic year, we moved from a set or fixed daily related arts schedule to a rotating related arts schedule. The rotating schedule is called the Related Arts Color Calendar. We rotate days using the color calendar because there are a disproportional number of days off on Mondays and Fridays. This used to mean students would have up to 6 fewer Monday or Friday related arts versus the other classes and days of the week. Your child's teacher will share their specific color calendar schedule with you and your child. You can refer to the color calendar below. It is very important to make sure your child dresses appropriately for the classes he/she has for related arts, especially for physical education.



### Water Bottles & Filling Station

Students are permitted to bring a water bottle or refillable containers to school. No other beverage is permitted in the classroom. \*No glass containers allowed.

This summer, we installed a new water bottle filling station in the Cafeteria. Students are welcome to refill their water bottle there.


### Join the THES PTA!
